Presidential Declaration on Accelerated Stunting Reduction in Africa

Collective Action by African Leaders to Stop Childhood Stunting, Increase Human Capital, and Drive Development

We, the undersigned members of the Presidential Dialogue Group on Nutrition, assembled during the 77th United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) to affirm our commitment to ending childhood stunting in our countries.

The Presidential Dialogue Group aims to accelerate reduction in stunting rates, while serving as an inspiration and blueprint for other countries in Africa and beyond. Working together with the African Development Bank through the African Leaders for Nutrition, the African Union Commission (AUC), and other member countries, we will amplify our impact and accelerate progress towards eliminating stunting across the continent.

More than 30 percent of African children are stunted—prevented from growing or developing properly—due to malnutrition and other underlying causes such as wasting, anemia, and low birth weight. In addition to the human cost, the economic burden of stunting is enormous, reducing countries' productivity and potential.

To significantly reduce the stunting rate, high-level political support is needed to develop programmatic interventions that target countries with a high prevalence of stunting. Therefore, the Presidential Dialogue Group has been established to augment the efforts by the African Development Bank through African Leaders for Nutrition to mobilize high-level political leadership to make nutrition a development priority on the national and continental agendas.

We also recognize that stunting cannot be addressed by any one sector. It will require multi-sectoral collaboration, bringing ministers across the cabinet together to forge collective solutions. We must break down traditional siloes and work towards one plan. In this regard, we note the success of Ethiopia's Seqota Declaration, the country's commitment to end stunting in children under two by 2030. With 2022 designated the Year of Nutrition by the African Union, the time for action is now. African Leaders for Nutrition is already working with AUC to develop a policy framework and a financing target to guide multi-sectoral nutrition programming and investment in the continent.
